**Robert Kahn:** A genius, German romantic composer, who was persecuted by the Nazis. His impressive repertoire was banned.

Born into a Jewish family of Mannheim, Germany, Kahn entered the KoniglichenHochschulein in Berlin in 1882. Three years later, he moved to Munich to improve his musical education. The young prodigy spent several months in Vienna with Johannes Brahms, who became his mentor. After his military service, Kahn went back to Berlin where he worked as a freelance composer. A gifted pedagogue, he trained the most famous musicians of the period including pianists Arthur Rubinstein and Wilhelm Kempf, conductor Ferdinand Leitner, and violinist Karl Klinger.

A piano virtuoso, Kahn was also an active performer of chamber music, and songs. A member of the Prussian Academy of Arts, he was removed from of his position by the Nazis in 1934, his music was prohibited, and all his performances were forbidden.

In 1938, Kahn was forced to emigrate to England. Despite his arduous situation, he did not stop composing. His impressive repertoire includes more than one thousand pieces for piano, music, songs, choral compositions and orchestral scores.

Robert Kahn died in Biddenden in Kent, England on May 29, 1951. His wonderful music deserves to be rediscovered.







An excerpt from Movement VI ("Danse de la fureur ..."), which is played by all four instruments in unison. It shows Messiaen's use of additive rhythms, in which the underlying quaver beat (eighth notes) is sometimes augmented by a semiquaver (sixteenth note).


# None of the speakers have been contacted. Yet!

# Date to be announced: ON THE WINGS OF LADINO SONGS


The resilience and the survival of the human spirit as interpreted through a lens with the life of Flory Jagody - a Bosnia survivor, raised in a Sephardic tradition.


